China Telecom kicks starts 3G mobile video streaming

Nokia Siemens Networks enables China's first 3G video streaming services

Subscribers for the first time have access to multimedia mobile applications such as live Mobile TV, video on demand and download. The centralized 3G CDMA EVDO video streaming platform can deliver a diverse range of audio and video formats nationwide services with sound and picture quality over 50% higher than 2G. The large capacity, advanced features, high stability and reliability of the streaming server engine makes it ideal to support live broadcasts, video on demand and downloading. In addition the video streaming service is flexible to handle and can easily be expanded with new consumer applications.
